The hotel promises a delicious 4-course menu every evening of your stay. Their half board arrangement offers a choice of 3 different main courses from their two 4 Course menus. Previous guests have said that at breakfast, they have a separate table laid out with ingredients for you to make a packed lunch. This hotel is also used by other hiking companies such as Headwater.

Kandersteg

Kandersteg is an attractive alpine village enjoying a relaxed and friendly atmosphere, and surrounded by beautiful mountain scenery in all directions. The main street is lined with inviting cafés and restaurants, and small shops selling local produce. The walking possibilities are excellent, with an abundance of trails around and above the village, from gentle strolls to more strenuous hill-walking. The Oeschinen cable-car, which is a pleasant 10 minute stroll from the village, whisks visitors up to the glorious scenery of the Oeschinen Lake. The Sunnbüel cable-car, a short bus ride away, has more walking trails and views.
